Continued recreation access to the Rizeor Lake and Lewis Butte trails depends on your cooperation staying on designated trails and your support of WDFW through purchase of a Discover or WDFW Vehicle Access Pass. Your actions not only affect recreational access here, but on other WDFW lands state wide. **Also, all dogs must be on a leash April 1 - July 31 during the fawning and ground bird nesting seasons.**
